DAY ONE—ARRIVAL INFORMATION

WELCOME TO QUEBEC!

Guests arrive at the Québec City Airport. Once they have passed immigrations/passport control officers, they will be greeted by uniformed Castle Travel Management Staff in the transit area and directed to the awaiting motorcoach.

CHECK-IN STAFFING SERVICES

Once guests arrive, they will be escorted to the Hospitality Desk for check-in. Guests are pre-registered and will not have to fill-in any registration forms; they give their names and will be handed their room key. The hotel, however, will take credit card imprints for guarantee of payment of incidentals.

Imagine how overwhelmed these distinguished guests would have been by the fabulous décor, and how charmed and sated by the delicious banquet concocted from them by Henry E. Journet, the famous chef whose offerings had already graced the best tables of Paris, London and Amsterdam.

Take a step back in time to visit the only walled city in North America. See the narrow, cobble streets, the historic buildings and unique "old world" ambiance of Québec City. Street corners and winding alleys will offer pleasant surprises for everyone. Shoppers will delight in the excellent selection of antiques, local art and specialty goods all available within easy walking distance.

A tour of the streets of Vieux-Québec (Old Québec City) proclaimed "World Heritage Treasure" by UNESCO in 1985, Place Royale and the National Assembly will provide visitors with the opportunity to discover a rich past which blends with the daily life of this charming city. Included are stops at

historic buildings: the Plains of Abraham - site of the decisive, final battle between the armies of Montcalm and Wolfe - and Le Petit Champlain, the oldest street in North America.

Upon returning to the hotel, lunch will be provided.
